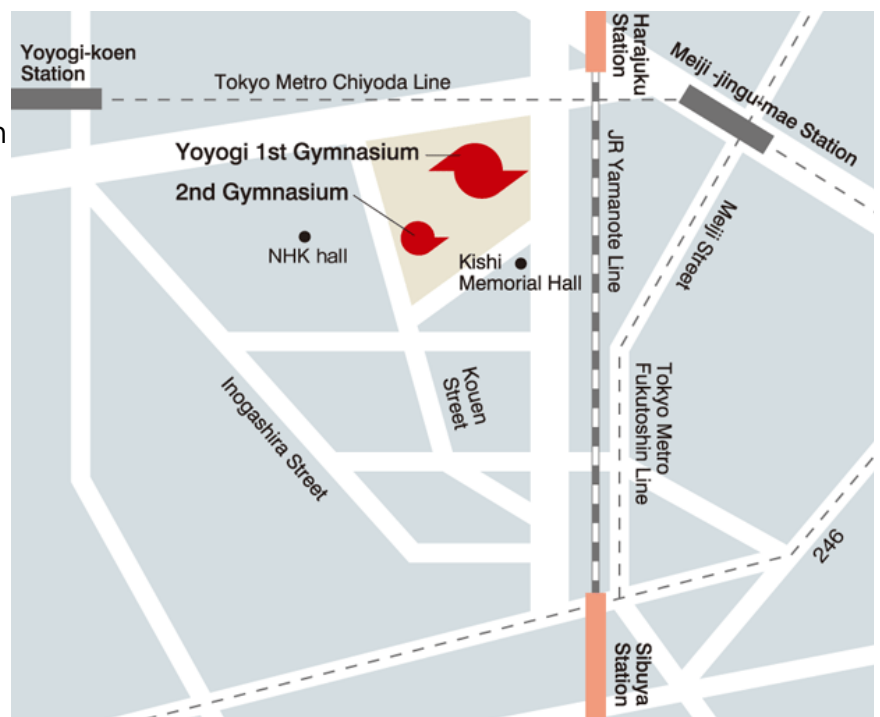

4. Notes on Application

- 1) **Deadline** for submission of application forms for players, coaches, referees and officials is **July 25 2026**. Please inform us about your flight schedule upon fixed.
- 2) To apply, enter the data of all participants (players, coaches, referees and officials) in the prescribed Excel form and submit it via e-mail along with a photograph of each participant. The photograph must be a color photograph of the applicant's upper body taken in karate gi or formal attire. A photo of the applicant's face only is not acceptable.

- 3) If you need a visa to enter Japan, please submit copies of all participants' passports and document (questions for visa to enter Japan) by July 25 2026.
Please note those who have been denied entry into Japan in the past are not eligible to apply.
- 4) The entry fee for overseas player shall be USD 50.

5. Other Notes

- 1) **The registration and weigh-in** for kumite competitors will be held on **November 22 from 2:00 to 4:00 pm at Yoyogi Gymnastic Hall 2**. (Kumite competition is Nov 23)
Please **bring your country's flag** and display it in the hall.
- 2) The weigh-in will be done wearing "karate gi" Considering the weight of karate gi, the excess within 2kgs will be allowed. In case of the excess over 2kgs, the competitor will be disqualified.
- 3) Sticker-type number cloths will be handed out at registration desk. Please affix it to the center of your back.
- 4) If a player who has applied for participation is unable to participate for any reason, please contact us as soon as possible.
- 5) Protest against the referee will not be accepted
- 6) Competitors are prohibited to wear any accessories.
Male competitors may not wear any shirt under their karate gi, even at the opening ceremony. The undershirt of female competitors must be white.
- 7) A **small gift corner from various countries** will be set up at the venue for the purpose of international exchange among all players, referees, staff, and supporters. Representatives from each country are asked to bring about 100 to 300 souvenirs, snacks, or memorabilia unique to their country. (Gifts should not be expensive.)
Everyone present will be able to receive a small gift from their favorite country.

<Order of kata games>

- In the preliminary round match, KATA1 shall be conducted individually, with 2-3 judges scoring the points. In case of a tie, the match will be decided by a rematch.
- The top 6 finishers from the preliminary rounds will go to semi-final matches.
- The semi-final and subsequent matches will be tournament format. Kata 2 will be performed. Only in the final match, each competitor perform their kata individually. In all other matches, two competitors will perform their kata simultaneously. The winner will be determined by flag decisions from three or more judges.
- The tournament bracket will be put from top to bottom by the qualifiers' 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 4th, and 1st place finishers.

<Evaluation Criteria>

- Basic point (Points are deducted from a maximum of 20 points)
 - Off-balance (Maximum ▲5 points) Unnecessary movement (▲5 points)
 - Inaccurate technique (▲5 points) Stiffness before performing the technique (▲5 points)
- Artistic point (30 points, Point addition method)
 - Dynamic movement (5 points) Impact of the technique (5 points)
 - Smooth, no breaks interlocking movement with hips (10 points)
 - Spirit and power that comes from moving with the flow of relaxed breathing (10 points)

Compete based on the total points of basic points and artistic points. In case of a tie, the winner is the one with the higher artistic points, and if the artistic points are also tied, the winner is the one with the higher spirit and power. If the match is still not resolved, it will be decided by a rematch.

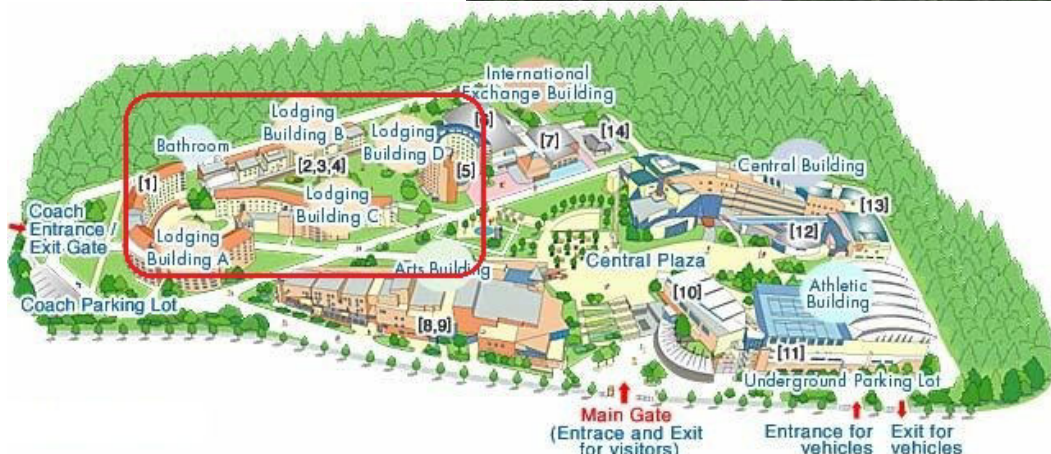

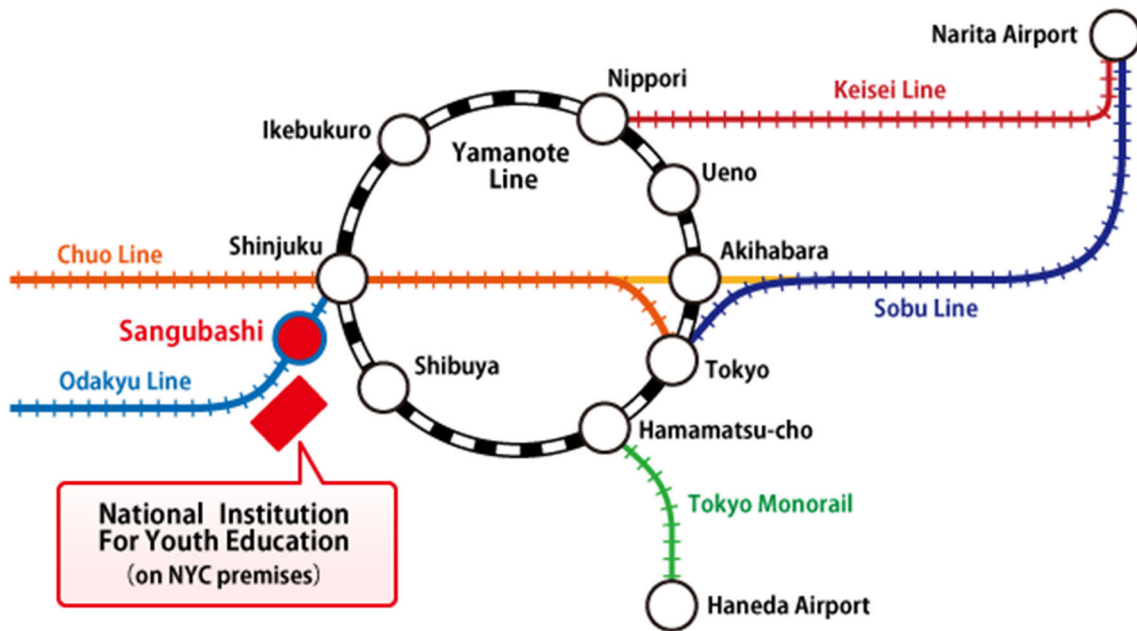

Sangubashi Station is about 3 minutes from Shinjuku.

The NIYE is about 7 minutes walk from Sangubashi station.

From Narita Airport

Take the JR Sobu Line to Shinjuku Station (Narita Express about 80-90 minutes).

Transfer to a local train on the Odakyu Line (about 3 minutes).

The NIYE is about 7 minutes walk from the station.

From Haneda Airport

Take the Tokyo Monorail to Hamamatsuchō (about 23 minutes).

Get JR Yamanote Line to Shinjuku (bound for Shibuya, about 23 minutes),

Or take the Keikyū Line to Shinagawa station (about 16 minutes).

Get JR Yamanote Line to Shinjuku (bound for Shibuya, about 23 minutes),

Transfer at Shinjuku station to local train on Odakyu Line.

Get off at Sangubashi station (about 3 minutes from Shinjuku).

The NIYE is about 7 minutes walk from the station.

By Subway (Chiyoda Line)

Get off at Yoyogi-Koen Station (Exit No. 4).

The NIYE is about 10 minutes walk from the Exit No. 4.
